Residents are being urged to make sure they are ready to vote in May by checking they have an accepted form of ID.

The full list of accepted ID is available on the Electoral Commission's website, along with more information about the new requirement and details of how to apply for the free ID, at electoralcommission.org.uk/voterID.

Anyone who wants to have their say in the elections this May must also be registered to vote. It only takes five minutes to register online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote. Voters wishing to apply to their council for free ID should first make sure they are registered to vote.

The deadline for submission of your nomination papers is **4th April 2023**. It is recommended that Nomination Packs are hand delivered to Wealden District Council in Hailsham. Please phone 01892 602 417 in advance for an appointment.

BUDGET 2023/24 Every year the Parish Council considers its budget requirements and the amount of income it will need to meet that budget. This income is called the Precept and makes up a portion of your Council Tax. We spend this money on items such as maintenance of public areas and assets, streetlights, litterbins, grit and dog bins, grants to local groups and supporting the local community.

Withyham Parish Council considered its budget for 2023/24, and were mindful that residents are experiencing a cost of living crisis. A balance had to be struck between providing services to our

community at a time when things we have to spend money on are going up, and keeping costs down for residents. Council therefore agreed expenditure of £214,384 and income of £43,550, leaving a precept request of £170,834. This represents an increase in the Precept of 4.6% or 11p per week on a band D property.
